Dear Commissioner Klein:

In response to your letter referenced above, Oregon currently regulates the use of all radioactive materials (including naturally occurring and accelerator produced material).

Oregon has been regulating the use of sources of radiation since at least 1948, with current statutory authority established in 1957 in preparation for signing the original agreement with the former US Atomic Energy Commission in 1965.

Oregon intends to continue regulation of all use of radioactive materials, including naturally occurring and accelerator-produced materials, and will certify this upon receipt of certification documents from the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission.
