Regarding:
STP-06-081 Opportunity to Comment on the Proposed Rule for the Secure Transfer of Nuclear Materials

This document addresses fingerprinting and criminal history record checks for any individual who is permitted unescorted access to radioactive materials at certain facilities. The NRC proposes to exempt licensees from this requirement, except pool-type irradiator, manufacturing and distribution, and licensees making shipments of RAMQC (Quantities of Concern). NRC is preparing additional orders under common defense and security for these additional requirements. These order will cover all individuals with unescorted access at the facilities, including persons "receiving" material at these facilities pursuant to import/export license. NRC has pre-empted the States with CD&S so the States and not required to amend our rules--the proposed compatibility category is "NRC."

The NRC approach seems reasonable to the OAS Executive Board.
