Dear Mr. Loux:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter of June 21, 2006, to Chairman Klein, about U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Yucca Mountain Project management issues. You included a presentation entitled "CR-6278 Requirements Management Root-Cause Analysis," dated November 2005.

In your letter, you state that you do not believe the NRC staff has either seen or evaluated the contents of the presentation. Let me assure you the NRC staff is well aware of the issues described in the presentation. Three reports by our On-Site Licensing Representatives in Las Vegas¹ and three presentations made at NRC/DOE quarterly management meetings² discuss the subject analysis, related condition reports, and corrective actions undertaken in response. As part of our prelicensing activities, the NRC staff will continue to monitor aggressively the identification of the root causes, and the corrective actions DOE is taking.
