**WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) UNIT 1 - NRC ORDER EA-06-137  
REQUIRING COMPLIANCE WITH KEY RADIOLOGICAL PROTECTION MITIGATION  
STRATEGIES**

The purpose of this letter is to respond to NRC's Order dated June 20, 2006. The Order required implementation of certain key radiological protection mitigation strategies to be incorporated into the plant security plan, safeguards contingency plan, guard training and qualification plan, and/or emergency plan, as appropriate. TVA consented to the Order by letter dated July 25, 2006. Subsequent to the Order and TVA's response, NRC issued a letter dated August 28, 2006, indicating that NRC had determined that the acceptance of the following license condition would be sufficient to satisfy the Order's requirements:

*[Licensee] shall implement and maintain all Actions required by Attachment 2 to NRC Order EA-06-137, issued June 20, 2006, except the last action that requires incorporation of the strategies into the site security plan, contingency plan, emergency plan and/or guard training and qualification plan, as appropriate.*

TVA agrees to have the WBN Operating License amended to include the above license condition and therefore, does not plan to submit any of the above plan changes.

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
