Dear Mr. Ragland

The University of Pittsburgh is requesting that our Broadscope License No. 37-00245-02 be amended as follows:

- 1) The ²³⁹ Pu/Be sources have been transferred to the DOE's offsite source recovery project and we are requesting that these sources be removed from the license;
- 2) other than exempt materials, we no longer incinerate radioactive waste on site and no longer dispose of incinerator ash. We wish to have the license condition that authorizes incinerator ash disposal removed from the license; and
- 3) the July 21, 2006 letter which we submitted to the NRC notifying it that a Varian Clinac Model 600C accelerator containing depleted uranium was transferred to VJ Technologies, Inc. was a notification only. We are not requesting a change in our depleted uranium possession limits.
