This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the safety inspection conducted on September 26, 2006, at the Dave Johnston Power Plant temporary job site outside of Casper, Wyoming. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under the general license pursuant to 10 CFR 150.20 as they related to radiation safety and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of the Agreement State license. A preliminary exit briefing was conducted with members of the plant staff at the conclusion of the on-site portion of the inspection. A final telephonic exit briefing was conducted with you on October 12, 2006.

Within the scope of this inspection no violations or deviations were identified; therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC Form 591M is required.
