Regarding your letter of April 1, 1999 related to the materials license application for Associated Cardiovascular Consultants, PA, we respond as follows:

1. The proposed location of materials use under this license, 76 Euclid Avenue, Haddonfield, NJ, is currently an area of use under NRC license #29-30171-01, Navix Diagnostics, Inc. That license has, to our knowledge, requested in writing to you to terminate licensed activities at this location; furthermore, a final closeout survey and materials disposition inspection is scheduled for May 10, 1999, at which time all license operations will cease for license #29-30171-01. Associated Cardiovascular Consultants, PA, does not intend to begin licensed operation until after this date.
2. Associated Cardiovascular Consultants, PA, has committed in its radiation safety program to a) conduct initial and annual refresher training in radiation safety and handling procedures for all authorized users, to be supervised by the Radiation Safety Officer, and b) conduct initial and refresher training in radiation safety, regulation, and operational work practices for all technologists and ancillary staff by the consultant health physicist, supervised by the Radiation Safety Officer. Additional training will be supplied regarding new or modified procedures and/or regulations on as needed basis.
