Please find attached the Final Status Survey Report for the Binghamton Depot. The survey was conducted per the Final Status Survey Plan approved by your letter dated August 23, 2006 and also per License Conditions 13, 14, and 15 as indicated in Amendment No. 26.

Results of the survey demonstrate that residual activity at the site meets the NRC limits for unrestricted release. We respectfully request that the DNSC Binghamton Depot, Hoyt Avenue, Binghamton, NY, be removed from the authorized location listing and that the facility be released for unrestricted use.
