SUPPLEMENTAL YUCCA MOUNTAIN REPOSITORY ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT (DOE/EIS-0250F-S1)

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE or the Department) is announcing its intent to prepare a Supplement to the "Final Environmental Impact Statement for a Geologic Repository for the Disposal of Spent Nuclear Fuel and High-Level Radioactive Waste at Yucca Mountain, Nye County, Nevada" (DOE/EIS-0250F, February 2002).

The Department invites comments on the scope of the Supplemental YM Repository EIS to ensure that all relevant environmental issues are addressed. DOE will consider all comments received during the 45-day public scoping period, which ends November 27, 2006. Comments received after this date will be considered to the extent practicable.
