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Meeting Summary for the NRC Public Meeting on the

Date: October 18, 2006

Place: Ohio State University (OSU) Endeavor Center; Piketon, Ohio

Purpose:

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the results of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Safety Evaluation Report and Final Environmental Impact Statement for the USEC Inc. gas centrifuge uranium enrichment facility proposed to be constructed in Piketon, Ohio. The meeting agenda is in Enclosure 3.

Discussion:

On October 18, 2006, the NRC staff held a public meeting to discuss its Safety Evaluation Report and final Environmental Impact Statement on the USEC Inc. American Centrifuge Plant, which is proposed to be built in Piketon, Ohio. The staff also noted that it expected the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board to conduct a site visit and hold a meeting to take comments from the public sometime in mid December 2006. After its presentations on these two documents, the staff answered questions related to socioeconomics, historical preservation issues, waste streams, safety and security issues, and depleted uranium tails storage and disposal. Approximately 50 people attended the two-hour meeting, which lasted until there were no more comments or questions from the public.
