In our letter dated May 15, 2006 PSEG Services Corporation requested that U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Materials License No. 29-02843-01 for Maplewood Testing Services (MTS) located in Maplewood, New Jersey be transferred to Exelon Services Company as a result of an anticipated merger of their respective parent companies, Public Service Enterprise Group Incorporated and Exelon Corporation.
