REMARKS: IP 71114.03 (Emergency Response Organization Staffing and Augmentation System) has been revised to add an objective for explicit review of Emergency Response Organization (ERO) staffing levels for adequacy using NUREG-0654, "Criteria for Preparation and Evaluation of Radiological Emergency Response Plans and Preparedness in Support of Nuclear Power Plants," Table B-1 as the standard. Added clarification on the review of the ERO responder training and qualifications. Added one Inspection Requirement (02.02.c) sub-section to make one-to-one correlation with the inspection guidance.

IP 71114.04 (Emergency Action Level and Emergency Plan Changes) has been revised to align it with RIS 2005-02, "Clarifying the Process for Making Emergency Plan Changes," concerning the correct process for making Emergency Plan changes with two clarifying flowcharts (Figures 1 & 2), addition to meet one commitment.

IP 71114.05 (Correction of Emergency Preparedness Weaknesses) has been revised to clarify that the inspection is associated with Planning Standard 10 CFR 50.47(b)(14), to focus on the timeliness and effectiveness of corrective actions based on safety significance, and conform to the Reactor Oversight Process emphasis on correction of emergency preparedness (EP) weaknesses.

IP 71114.06 (Drill Evaluation) has been revised to clarify that the EP cornerstone licensee response band is established by the performance indicators (PI) system and the licensee's corrective action program, the importance of the formal critique process to identify EP weaknesses, and that this inspection activity is associated with planning standard 10 CFR 50.47(b)(14).

IP 71114.07 (Force-On-Force (FOF) Exercise Evaluation) has been revised to enhance procedural guidance based on feedback received from the implementation of this procedure in the field.
