
It has come to our attention that Amendment No. 08, sent as Amendment No. 07, to NRC License No. 13-32087-01 contained an error. Amendment No. 07 in response to your request dated April 4, 2006, should have read Amendment No. 08. Enclosed is a corrected copy of your NRC license reflecting the correct amendment No.

During our telephone conversation on June 9, 2006, you informed us that currently your licensed program does not have any Authorized Users, Authorized Medical Physicists or a Radiation Safety Officer. In light of this information, please note that Items 9.A and 9.B of your NRC license only authorizes possession and storage in standby of all byproduct material. Also you must amend your license prior to any use. We also remind you of the requirements in 10 CFR 30.36(d)(2) and (3) that requires a licensee, to within 60 days, provide notification to the commission when the licensee has decided to permanently cease principle activities or no principal activities under the license have been conducted for a period of 24 months. You did notify the Commission in you letter dated February 15, 2006, that principle activities have ceased. Therefore, in the remaining time frame, you must decide whether principle activities will commence or cease in which case you need to properly dispose of any remaining byproduct material, perform a closeout survey of your facilities and terminate your NRC license.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
