Dear Sir or Madame,

Please amend our byproduct materials license, 37-07939-01, to remove the use and possession of depleted Uranium 235, 160 kg, as Cd-plated metal. Please also delete the use and possession of 10 CFR 31.11 materials. Please find enclosed a copy of the radioactive material license of the recipient of the depleted Uranium. Other materials to support this transfer were submitted to Shirley Xu, of your office, following a recent inspection. Since these materials have not been used at any campus other than the Bethlehem Campus, and since the cessation of their use was over ten years ago, the final or "close-out" survey is no longer available (personnel present at that time are no longer employees of SLHN, and current staff do not maintain these records), but a "close-out survey" was performed for this area at the time of cessation of operations, prior to turnover for unrestricted use of that area.

Please accept this fax as acknowledgement that RS&A, Inc. procured a Varian Clinac 4 linear accelerator, serial number 137, from St. Luke's Hospital in Bethlehem, PA. This machine was removed from the facility and transported to the RS&A, Inc. warehouse in Rural Hall, NC, on or about July 14, 2003.

The depleted uranium, which RS&A, Inc. is authorized to possess, use, and transfer, was placed in the control area of the warehouse, and the machine was later scrapped for parts and then disposed of to Atlantic Scrap and Processing, LLC in Winston-Salem, NC, on or about April 20, 2005.

- 13. The licensee is not authorized to energize the accelerator for the purpose of producing a photon or electron beam



The licensec is authorized to possess, use, and transfer the Uranium contained as shielding material in the accelerator unit(s) authorized by this license.



The licensee shall annually review its Radiation Protection Program for content and implementation [Ref. 15A NCAC 11 .1603(c)]. Documentation of the Radiation Protection Program reviews shall be retained for inspection by the ligency [Ref. 15A NCAC 11 .1636]

- The licensee shall institute the provisions of 15A NCAC 11 .1610 when an occupationally exposed woman voluntarily informs her 16. supervisor, in writing, of her pregnancy and the estimated date of conception,
- The licensee shall ensure that no individual "member of the public" [Ref. 15A NCAC 11 .0104(64)] receives airadiation dose in 17. excess of the limits specified in 15A NCAC 11 1611(a) while conducting licensed activities
- 18. Neither this license not any subsequent amendments shall be deemed to constitute compliance with the requirements for health planning review contained in the Certificate of Need Statute, G.S. 131-175 et seq., and regulations promulgated pursuant to that statute. Inquiries concerning the Certificate of Need Statute should be addressed to the Certificate of Need Section of the Division of Facility Services at (919) 733-6360.
- 19. This license may be subject to amendment, revision, modification, suspension, or revocation in accordance with the provisions of 15A NCAC 11, .0344.
