The U.S. Department of the Interior (Department) has reviewed the Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS) for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants (NUREG-1437, Supplement 28) regarding Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station. The Department's U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) commented in response to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Notice of Intent to prepare an Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed project in a letter dated November 23, 2005.
