Dear Mr. Lawyer,

Dr Howard Kramer has completed a training program in nuclear cardiology that meets the requirements as outlined in the ACC/ASNC COCATS Guidelines. Dr Kramer is competent to independently function as an authorized user under 10 CFR 35.290 uses.

Dr Kramer fulfilled the experience elements as required by 10 CFR 290 (c)(ii) and was supervised by myself or my designee in the following elements :

1. Ordering , receiving, and unpacking radioactive materials safely and performing the related surveys.
2. Performing quality control procedures on instruments used to determine the activity of dosages and performing checks for proper operation of survey meters.
3. Calculating, measuring and safely preparing patient or human research subject dosages.
4. Using administrative controls to prevent a medical event involving the use of unsealed byproduct material.
5. Using procedures to safely contain spilled radioactive material and using proper decontamination procedures
6. Administering dosages of radioactive drugs to patients or human research subjects
7. Eluting generator systems appropriate for preparation of radioactive drugs for imaging and localization studies, measuring and testing the eluate for radionuclide purity and processing the eluate with reagent kits to prepare radioactive drugs.

The elements 1-4, 6 and 7 were verified by Dr Kramer's Logs. Element 5 was supervised by the RSO, Lily Lodhi, PhD.
