Dear Mr. Krich,

By letter dated October 27, 2006, UniStar Nuclear resubmitted for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff review, Revision 1 of Topical Report (TR) UN-TR-06-0001, QAPD. The NRC staff has performed an acceptance review of UniStar's Quality Assurance Program Description (QAPD), Revision 1, and found that the changes to the original document will require two additional weeks for the staff to issue both the request for additional information (RAI) letter and the safety evaluation report (SER). Therefore, the revised dates are as follows: the staff expects to transmit a request for additional information (RAI) letter by November 29, 2006, and issue its SER by March 14, 2007. The staff does not expect a change in the resource estimates that were originally provided. The revised review schedule milestones were discussed in a telephone call with you on November 28, 2006.

Section 170.21 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* requires that TRs are subject to fees based upon the full cost of the review. You did not request a fee exemption; therefore, staff hours and the contractor cost, if applicable, will be billed accordingly.
