Dear Mr. Brown:

By letter dated May 25, 2006, GENE submitted for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff review Topical Report (TR) NEDE-32906P, Supplement 3, "Migration to TRACG04/PANAC11 from TRACG02/PANAC10 for TRACG AOO [Anticipated Operational Occurrences] and ATWS [Anticipated Transient Without Scram] Overpressure Transients." The NRC staff has performed an acceptance review of NEDE-32906P, Supplement 3. We have found that the material presented is sufficient to begin our comprehensive review. The NRC staff expects to issue its request for additional information by November 27, 2006, and issue its draft safety evaluation by May 25, 2007. The NRC staff estimates that the review will require approximately 160 staff hours including project management time. The review schedule milestones and estimated review costs were discussed and agreed upon in a telephone conference between Jim Harrison of your staff and the NRC staff on November 1, 2006.

Section 170.21 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* requires that TRs are subject to fees based on the full cost of the review. You did not request a fee waiver; therefore, NRC staff hours will be billed accordingly.
