Dear Ms. Owens,

Westinghouse Electric Company LLC. would like to amend our NRC Waste License XW003 which permits the export of uranium contaminated steel and other items to Mississauga Metals Inc. in Canada. The current license states the forms of uranium contamination on these items as either UF6 or UO2. We wish to amend XW003 to read "uranium in all its various forms from U3O8 to UO2" as this will pick up the various chemical forms of the uranium contamination as it progressed through the fabrication process. There are no changes in any of the items to be exported or in the amounts of uranium contamination or its isotope concentration. This is just a change in the description on the forms of the uranium contamination so as to include them all on the face of the waste license.

A check for \$300 is included with this amendment request to cover the NRC application fee. We humbly request a waiver of the 30 day Federal Register notice as this is a very minor paperwork clarification amendment which offers no change in anything previously reported in past federal register notices concerning this waste license.
