

The purpose of this modification is to add a task under the Statement of Work of the basic contract (at no additional cost), extend the period of performance of the basic contract (at no additional cost) and replace the Project Officer as follows:

1. The Statement of Work (Section C.1.4) is hereby revised to add the following task:

TASK 5.

Following review and management approval of the site-specific Phase 3 assessment reports, the NRC staff will send a letter to the licensee for each site providing a summary of the Phase 3 report and requesting implementation details for licensee actions to be taken in response to Phases 2 and 3. As directed by the NRC Project Officer, the contractor shall technically assist the NRC staff in reviewing the licensee responses and preparing a safety evaluation report (SER) for each site. It is anticipated that the licensee responses and SERs will contain Safeguards Information (SGI). Therefore, contractor staff will need to perform their work at NRC Headquarters or at another facility that is authorized to store and handle SGI.

Contractor travel is estimated to be twenty-four (24) 2-week person-trips to NRC headquarters.

Estimated level of effort: 12 staff-months

Estimated completion date: March 15, 2007

2. The period of performance (Section F.5) is hereby revised to read as follows:
