2. Supplement H of reference 1a to subject license stipulates this command's radiation protection program as it relates to the life cycle management control of the MX-7338/PDR-27R Radioactive Test Sample including qualified responsible personnel fulfilling the depot responsibility for radiation protection for this test sample. Mr. Joseph M. King, Chief, Nucleonics Branch, Lexington-Blue Grass Depot Activity (LBDA) was designated to serve in the capacity of radiation protection officer (RPO) for LBDA and Mr. Frederick T. Toyama, Chief, Nucleonics Branch, Metrology Division, Directorate of Quality Assurance, Sacramento Army Depot (SAAD) was designated to serve in the capacity of RPO for SAAD.

3. As of 1 October 1980, the Nucleonics Branch, LBDA was reorganized into the US Army Ionizing Radiation Dosimetry Center (AIRDC) and the Nucleonics Branch, SAAD was reorganized into the Nucleonics Laboratory Branch, US Army Calibration




