1. Reference is made to the following:

a. Meeting, 25 June 1982, between Messrs. Paul Guinn, John Hickey and James Wong, NRC Materials Licensing Branch, Mr. Thomas Grucci, DARCOM Safety Office, and the undersigned, CECOM Safety Office, subject as above.

b. Letter, DRSEL-SF-MR, dated 15 June 1982, subject: US NRC Special Nuclear Material License No. SNM-1896.

c. Letter, DRSEL-SF-MR, dated 10 May 1982, subject: US NRC License No. SMB-1300.

d. Letter, DRSEL-SF-MR, dated 18 May 1982, subject: US NRC Byproduct Material License No. 29-01022-11.

2. As discussed and concurred in reference 1a meeting, the following general conditions are requested for implementation with regard to NRC licenses governing CECOM managed commodities:

a. "Licensed material shall be used by Department of Defense installations/activities worldwide." or "Licensed material may be used anywhere in the United States."

b. "Licensed material shall be used by, military and/or civilian personnel under direct control of the Department of the Army."

3. General license conditions specified in paragraph 2 above are applicable to requested license amendments contained in reference 1b and 1d. These conditions have been amended and incorporated into the license document as requested in reference 1c.
