

Gentlemen:

Headquarters Department of the Army forwarded an application 1 August 1973 for a USAEC Byproduct Material License for issue to the US Army Electronics Command, Fort Monmouth, New Jersey. Conversations between this office and Mr. K. Hebron, AEC have indicated that the application failed to reach the Commission. Attached are two copies of that application. We would appreciate expeditious handling due to the delay already encountered. The license is needed to authorize Fort Monmouth to possess 70 curies of sealed Krypton -85 sources, each source being less than 7 millicuries. This material is currently held by Edgewood Arsenal under license No. 19-01826-02. However, the logistics responsibility for the item in which the material is used is being transferred to the US Army Electronics Command.
