1. Reference is made to the following:

a. Letter, DRSEL-SF-H, dated 11 April 1977, subject: Additional Supporting Information Pertaining to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Source Material License Application.

b. Letter, SDSSA-ASO, dated 14 November 1980, subject: Training and Experience of Radiation Protection Officer and Alternate (Incl 1).

2. Reference 1a of subject license stipulates this command's radiation protection program as it relates to the life cycle management control of Forward Looking Infra Red (FLIR) imaging systems and subsystems including qualified responsible personnel fulfilling the depot responsibility for radiation protection for these FLIR systems and subsystems. Mr. Frederick T. Toyama, Chief, Nucleonics Branch, Metrology Division, Directorate of Quality Assurance, Sacramento Army Depot (SAAD) was designated to serve in the capacity of radiation protection officer (RPO) for SAAD.

3. As of 1 October 1980, the Nucleonics Branch, SAAD was reorganized into the Nucleonics Laboratory Branch, US Army Calibration Repair Center - Sacramento, is part of the US Army Metrology and Calibration Center, Redstone Arsenal, Alabama and is now a tenant activity located on SAAD property. Mr. Toyama no longer provides the RPO function for SAAD. Mr. Herman E. McGrew, Safety Office, SAAD has been designated by the Commander, SAAD to serve in the capacity of RPO for SAAD in place of Mr. Toyama. Reference 1b contains Mr. McGrew's qualifications.

4. Request amendment to subject license be granted to include this change.


