NRC STAFF STATUS REPORT

The Atomic Safety and Licensing Board issued an Order dated April 6, 2006, directing the Staff to file a status report at intervals not to exceed three months or whenever an event occurs that materially affects the scheduling in the criminal proceeding. Since the last status report, filed on October 26, 2006, significant events have occurred affecting the scheduling in the criminal proceeding.

On October 31, 2001, the court held a conference call to discuss pending motions and a trial date. Thereafter, the court issued the attached Order on November 1, 2006, setting forth filing deadlines and setting a trial date of April 17, 2007, with voir dire to begin on April 16. In the event the trial does not go forward on April 17, the court set July 16, 2007 as the back-up trial date. The court set March 2, 2007, as the deadline for the government to provide *Jencks* and *Brady* materials and for the defendants to enter a change of plea. The court set

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November 17, 2006, as the deadline for the government to respond to the motions filed by the defendants on October 20. The court extended the deadline for filing motions to November 20, 2006, and excluded that additional time from the requirements of the Speedy Trial Act.
