Addendum 8 to Renewal Application


The University of Virginia is a state corporation under the control of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Virginia, Section 23-114, Code of Virginia, as amended. Accordingly, the University of Virginia is a state government licensee as defined in Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 30.35(f)(4).

I, Leonard W. Sandridge, Jr., acting in my capacity as Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, am authorized by the Board of Visitors of the University of Virginia to issue this Statement of Intent on behalf of the University of Virginia.

The University of Virginia currently holds NRC license Number 45-00034-26, a Broad Scope byproduct materials license. The referenced license describes the facilities and activities for which this Statement of Intent is provided. The University of Virginia has no present plans to decommission its facilities.

Should the University of Virginia terminate its license, it is estimated that the decommissioning costs would be \$750,000. This figure is based on the table contained in Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 30.35(d). The University of Virginia reserves the right to reassess this funding estimate at the time of license termination. As a state agency, the University of Virginia is subject to a bi-annual appropriation from the General Assembly. In the event that the University of Virginia decides to relinquish its NRC license, it agrees to request an appropriation from the General Assembly to cover the decommissioning costs sufficiently in advance to prevent any delays in required decommissioning activities.
