
Sir or Madam:

Such proceedings are governed by Rule 26-106, Florida Administrative Code. A petition for administrative hearing must be in writing and must be received by the Agency Clerk for the Department within twenty-one (21) days from the receipt of this order. Review proceedings are governed by the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. Such proceedings may be commenced by filing one copy of a Notice of Appeal with the Agency Clerk of the Department of Health and a second copy, accompanied by the filing fees required by law, with the Court of Appeals in the appropriate District Court. The notice must be filed within 30 days of rendition of the final order.
