SUBJECT: SUMMARY FROM PUBLIC MEETING DISCUSSION OF
IMPLEMENTATION GUIDANCE FOR SUBPART I, OF THE PART 26
FITNESS FOR DUTY PROGRAM RULE

On Thursday, November 9, 2006, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) hosted a public meeting with industry stakeholders. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss implementation guidance for Subpart I of the Part 26 Fitness for Duty rule program. Representatives from the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) presented a draft guidance document (NEI-06-11) titled, "Managing Fatigue at Power Reactor Sites." NEI 06-11 was developed to better understand what changes might need to be made for NRC to consider endorsement of part or all of the document for use at licensed facilities. Stakeholders from the Union of Concerned Scientists (UCS), International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), and the Electrical Power Research Institute (EPRI) were also in attendance.

The meeting provided a means for technical interchange on the topics among the various stakeholders and for NRC staff to determine further steps for development or endorsement of implementation guidance. There will be another public meeting on December 13, 2006, from 8:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. to continue discussion of the guidance development process.
