Dr. Albert J. Barrett has successfully completed the examination requirements of the American Osteopathic Board of Radiology (AOBR) leading to certification in Diagnostic Radiology.

The AOBR examines candidates for certification and submits their credentials to the American Osteopathic Association (AOA). The Bureau of Osteopathic Specialists (BOS) is the official body of the AOA authorized to take final action on specialty hoard recommendations for certification. Dr. Barrett's credentials and recommendation for certification will be transmitted to the AOA by November 1. The AOA will send a mail ballot to the BOS on November 30 to obtain final approval of the recommendations. It is the policy of the AOA that the certification status of a physician must be verified through the AOA Office and not by the examining board.
