Dear Sir or Madam:

I think the proposed regulation is unnecessarily incomprehensible. Specific examples are the proposed 10CFR30.32 (j) and essentially identical (for this example) 30.34(j)

"(j) Each applicant for a license for byproduct material subject to the requirements of part 73 of this chapter shall protect Safeguards Information against unauthorized disclosure in accordance with the requirements in §§ 73.21 and 73.23 of this chapter, as applicable".

In an attempt to see if this proposed regulation applied to me, I was unable to follow the logic in §§ 73.21 or 73.23. Why not state what you mean?

I suggest:

(j) Each applicant for a license for byproduct material in amounts greater than those listed in Appendix XXX of 10CFR ## must develop and implement a physical security plan to prevent unauthorized access and shall protect Safeguards Information against unauthorized disclosure in accordance with the requirements in §§ 73.21 and 73.23 of this chapter, as applicable

This requires an appendix, but it would still be clearer than what you propose. You could also in the same appendix define the RAMQC amounts in a separate table.
