Temple University would like to update you on the current status of the Temple University School of Dentistry Building, 3223 North Broad Street, Philadelphia, PA. The building is an authorized location of use under Condition 10 of the above referenced license as a part of the Health Sciences Center specific listing. All known radioactive materials have been removed from the School of Dentistry building and all areas approved for radioactive material usage have been surveyed for radiation exposure as well as for fixed and removable contamination. The survey was performed with GM, NaI, and ionization chamber detectors. Wipe testing was analyzed by liquid and gamma well scintillation counting. Nothing above background levels was detected as a result of the surveys. We have therefore, released the building for unrestricted use but would like to maintain the building's eligibility as an authorized location of radioactive material usage, as resumption of such use may be planned in the future.
