Dear Senator Clinton:

I recently had the opportunity to lead a U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) delegation to India to meet with the Indian Atomic Energy Regulatory Board and other Indian governmental officials and to visit a variety of civilian nuclear facilities. This visit was part of NRC's implementation of the nuclear cooperation component of Phase Two of the United States government's Next Steps in Strategic Partnership (NSSP) with India.

This trip provided me with a much higher appreciation of the Indian capabilities in the civilian nuclear sector, as well as a greater understanding of the importance that the Indian Government places on the nuclear cooperation component of the NSSP. Ambassador Mulford believed that you would be interested in the results of this continued dialogue in your capacity as co-chair of the Senate India Caucus. The Ambassador suggested that I offer you a short briefing on the results of my visit and current Indian views of the NSSP.
