Radiation Safety Management Experience:

1999-2003: DuPont Pharmaceuticals Company / Bristol Myers-Squibb, worked with the RSO to perform the following duties for the Chemical Enzymology group:

- 1) Conducted receipt, delivery and contamination surveys for arriving shipments of radioactive material, H-3, C-14, P-32, S-35, I-125.
- 2) Ensured, record keeping and inventory, that quantities of radioactive material did not exceed license requirements.
- 3) Maintained dosimetry program, determined if dosimetry was needed, distributed and collected personnel monitoring devices, monitored dosimetry results for trends and high exposures.
- 4) Ensured radiation exposures were "ALARA" by reviewing all laboratory procedures and staging trial "dry runs" without isotope.
- 5) Conducted training programs in proper handling of radioactive materials prior to use, annually as a refresher, and as required by changes in procedures, equipment, regulations, for chemical enzymology group.
- 6) Coordinated radioactive waste disposal with approved vendor, maintained waste disposal area, and maintained disposal records.
- 7) Arranged for calibration of all radiation monitoring instruments.
- 8) Performed periodic audits of the radiation safety program and communicated results and corrective actions to chemical enzymology group.
- 9) Investigated incidents, accidents and exposures, and recommended corrective actions.
