Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Epstein of this office on February 16, 1972, of activities authorized by AEC Byproduct Material License No. 29-01022-06, and to the discussion of our findings held by Mr. Epstein with Dr. W. Ramm and Mr. C. Pullen of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by our inspector, and observations by our inspector.

In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined the circumstances of a leaking source reported in your letter dated October 8, 1971 to the Director, Division of Materials Licensing. We have no further questions concerning this occurrence.

Within the scope of the inspection no items of noncompliance were observed.

No reply to this letter is necessary; however, should you have any questions concerning this inspection, we would be pleased to discuss them with you.
