By letter dated September 28, 2006, the NRC issued Regulatory Issue Summary 2006-21, Improving Response Capabilities Through the Use of An Incident Response Electronic Library. The purpose of this letter is to notify NRC that Florida Power & Light Company (FPL), the owner and operator of the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, and Turkey Point Nuclear Plant, Units 3 and 4; FPL Energy Seabrook, LLC, the owner of a controlling interest in and operator of Seabrook Station; and FPL Energy Duane Arnold, LLC, the owner of a controlling interest in and operator of Duane Arnold Energy Center (collectively FPL), will voluntarily participate as requested. The information requested will be provided during the first quarter of 2007. Please note that Seabrook has provided the information based on their participation as a pilot plant.

FPL will continue to monitor the NRC process for periodically updating the information.
