Your query has been referred to me for response.

You are correct that 10 CFR 35, Subpart J is no longer effective. You are not correct in saying that only individuals who are board certified in an approved field can become Authorized Users (AUs).

Each section of Part 35 that specifies training and experience requirements for an individual to be authorized, e.g. 10 CFR 35.290 or 10 CFR 35.390, includes at least one alternate pathway to authorization for those individuals who are not certified by a board recognized by NRC or an Agreement State under that section. You should seek authorized status under an alternate pathway to AU, i.e., under 10 CFR 35.290(c)(1) or 10 CFR 35.390(b)(1). You should seek authorized status under an alternate pathway to RSO, i.e., under 10 CFR 35.50(b)(1) or (c)(2).
