Dr. Mr. Janosko:

License Condition 9.5 of the Source Material License SUA-1548 requires annual Surety Estimate revisions for the Power Resources Inc. (PRI) Ruth and North Butte Facilities. As your staff is aware, the Surety Estimates and Letters of Credit for each of these facilities are separate to accommodate the separate WDEQ-LQD Mine Permits.

Due to the non-operational status of these two facilities, the existing sureties will remain at \$78,800 for the North Butte Facility and \$104,600 for the Ruth Facility for the next surety period. No development or operational activities are planned for the next surety period.
