License -6

This is a broad license, but the quantity of material on hand, its physical form (sealed sources) and its use rate, are such that the program would be classified relatively light. It is well managed. I found no concern for health or safety. I recommend that it be reinspected at the normal interval plus six months (4/68).

License -7

This covers a 3.5 kilocurie Co-60 source used in a hot cell. It is well designed and presents no problem regarding health or safety. I recommend reinspection at the normal interval plus one year (10/69).
