Thank you for your letter of November 14, which we received on November 16, regarding the above-referenced Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) proposed approval of a license renewal. We appreciate your effort in identifying historic properties for this undertaking.

We understand that the license renewal application does not propose action in the undeveloped portions of Westinghouse's site. The site as a whole has a very high probability of significant archaeological properties. Any future proposed expansion or ground disturbance in previously-undisturbed areas should be submitted to our office for review and comment.

Based on the information provided, our office concurs with NRC's assessment that no properties included in or eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places will be affected by this project.
