Enclosed for your information is a letter from Integral Solids & Solutions, dated December 28, 2006, requesting Amendment No. 2 to NRC export license XSOU8764 to extend the expiration date from March 31, 2007 to March 31, 2012. All other conditions of this NRC license authorizing the export of natural uranium and thorium contained in calcium aluminate slag for use as a steelmaking additive (non-nuclear end use) to Canada will remain unchanged.

Since no other changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license are requested, we intend to issue this minor amendment after the required 30-day time period allotted for public review expires and it is determined that applicable export license criteria are met.
