

I attended Maria Parham School of Radiological Technology in Henderson, N.C., from 1971-1973. Maria Parham at that time was a hospital based 24 month Radiological Technology training course. The school has since closed and is now affiliated with the Community College system in Henderson N.C. Courses consisted of class room hours and clinical work, split approximately 60% classroom the first year and approximately 70% clinical the last year. Our classroom courses were Anatomy and Physiology, Radiation Physics, Radiation Protection, Pathology, Positioning courses, Radiation safety, general patient safety, limited nursing and first aide training and Radiation Therapy. We had hands on clinical training with X-Ray equipment, Geiger counters, Radiation Therapy equipment and various lab equipment.
