1. Investigated overexposure, accidents, spills, uses, transfers, disposals, losses, misadministrations and other deviations from approved radiation safety practice and has implemented corrective actions as necessary.
2. Established implemented written policies and procedures for:
 - a. Authorizing the purchase of byproduct material
 - b. Receiving and opening packages of byproduct materials
 - c. Storing byproduct material
 - d. Keeping an inventory record of byproduct material
 - e. Using byproduct material safety
 - f. Taking emergency action if control of byproduct material is lost
 - g. Performing periodic radiation surveys
 - h. Performing checks of survey instruments and other safety equipment
 - i. Disposing of byproduct material
 - j. Training personnel who work in or frequent areas where byproduct material is used or stored
 - k. Keeping a copy of all records and reports required by the Commission regulations, a copy of Commission regulations, a copy of each licensing request and license amendments, and the written policies and procedures required by the regulations.
3. Evaluated the byproduct material program annually.
4. Investigated exposure levels which have exceeded established and

investigational levels for the cause of the exposure.

In addition, **Amanda J Rahr** assisted in preparing the hospital's Radiation Disaster Response Plan. She also served as a resource person for other Departments in addressing radiation related concerns. **Amanda J Rahr** has designed and implemented methods to measure radiation exposure to non-occupationally exposed persons; and has reported the results to the Radiation Safety Committee.

Amanda J Rahr is well aware of the duties and responsibilities of the Radiation Safety Officer in assuring that employees and the public are protected from radiation hazard. I feel that **Amanda J Rahr** possesses the requisite knowledge and experience to be a dedicated, capable Radiation Safety Officer.

Amanda J Rahr will be granted full authority in the position of RSO to control activities related to radiation safety.

You, Amanda J Rahr, have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff do not cooperate and do not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time. It is estimated that you will spend 8-10 hours per week conducting radiation protection activities.

I accept the above responsibilities.


