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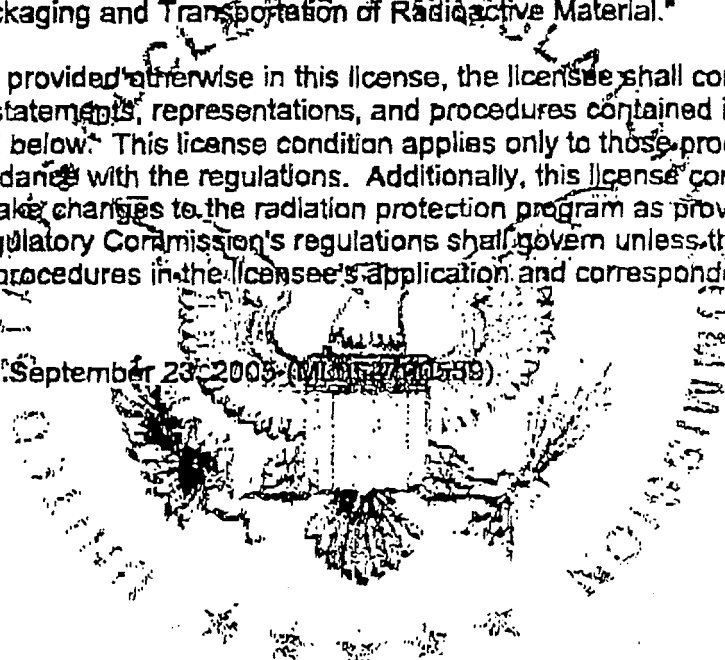

- 12. The Radiation Safety Officer for this license is George L. Popky, M.D.
