SUBJECT: REPORT AND STAFF EVALUATION OF THE COLORADO RADIATION
CONTROL PROGRAM

Transmitted herewith is the subject report and staff evaluation.

As noted in the report, no significant problems were noted in the Colorado program. The staffing level has decreased somewhat from the previous review. The State is now operating at a level of about 1.22 man-years per 100 licenses. Additional staff in uranium mill licensing and compliance may be necessary.

Based on the results of the meeting, the staff recommends that the next regulatory program review meeting be conducted in 12-18 months.

This report is late due to extended leave and the heavy workload since the time of the meeting.
