The laboratory has asked SAIC if we can dispose of the unused portions of the deer samples. We had hoped to receive some feedback from STV during last Friday's call. However, as you know, Diane Henschel, had to leave the call before the deer and other biota topic was discussed. STV indicated that she had comments, but maybe just on the sampling of other biota. SAIC will start to incur extra costs if we request the lab to continue holding

the samples. Is it possible and would it be appropriate for you to send STV an e-mail requesting general comments on the deer/other biota sampling. Surely, they could send an e-mail this week so that we have some idea of what future discussions will be. This will help us determine if we can release the samples. I do not believe that we should let them know the decision we are trying to reach because they might then request additional analyses if they know that possibility still exists.
