

PRM-35-20
(71FR64168)

I favor granting the petition for rulemaking from Dr. Ritenour to restore recognition of diplomates of certifying boards that were recognized in 10 CFR Part 35 prior to October 25, 2005. Failure to recognize certification prior to 10/25/05 disqualifies the large majority of certified medical physicists with no evidence that there is any distinction in training, education, or other qualifications between those disqualified and those still qualified under the rule. This kind of arbitrary, unsupported distinction burdens licensees without improving patient or facility safety in any demonstrable way.

Please approve the petition for rulemaking.
