Dear Madam Secretary,

This correspondence is to request action under the following points:

- 1. Request that the NRC grant the AAPM Petition for Rulemaking PRM-35-20.
- 2. Amend 10 CFR § 35.57, Training for experienced Radiation Safety Officer, teletherapy or medical physicist, authorized medical physicist, authorized user, nuclear pharmacist, and authorized nuclear pharmacist, to recognize medical physicists certified by either the ABR or the ABMP on or before October 24, 2005.
- a. This is a true grandfather provision for the individuals and has no relationship to the grandfathering of the process used by a certifying board prior to the adoption of the new regulation.
- 3. Amend 10 CFR § 35.57 to recognize all diplomates that were certified by the named boards in Subpart J for RSO who have relevant timely work experience even if they have not been formally named as an RSO (or as either an "Assistant or Associate RSO").
