This letter is to provide support to the Petition for Rulemaking (PRM-35-20) filed by E. Russell Ritenour, Ph.D. on behalf of the American Association of Physicists in Medicine.

I support the petition to request that the NRC needs to amend 10 CFR Part 35 to recognize the medical physicists certified by ABR or ABMP before October 25, 2005. There is no evidence to support a rulemaking assertion that there is significant difference between the board certification requirements and process before and after October 25, 2005.

In addition, the new 10 CFR part 35 which was published on April 24, 2002 specifies that an individual must have a statement signed by a "preceptor AMP" attesting that the individual is capable of acting independently for the specified modality. However, without medical physicists listed on licenses prior to the new regulation, there is limited opportunity for a medical physicist to serve as a preceptor. Therefore, this requirement is inconsistent with the previous regulations before the concept of the AMP was introduced.

I would appreciate that the NRC to amend the Part 35 as stated in the Petition for rulemaking (PRM-35-20).
