Dear Mr. McConnell:

Following discussion with Mr. Paul Michalak of the NRC staff on December 22, 2006, United Nuclear Corporation (UNC) proposes to amend the subject license as follows:

### Existing Condition

- 30.C. The licensee shall, on a semiannual frequency, submit a ground-water monitoring report as well as submit a corrective action program review, by December 31 of each year, that describes the progress towards attaining ground-water protection standards.

### Justification

Annual reporting of the corrective action program review is presently due by December 31 of each year. This deadline is logistically difficult for UNC to meet because such reporting includes receipt and analysis of the fourth quarter (October) groundwater sampling laboratory analytical results. The laboratory results are typically not received by UNC until approximately November 15 to December 1.

UNC requests a revised submittal deadline of January 30 of the following calendar year, versus the current submittal deadline of December 31 of the same calendar year. This request is made so that the development of this comprehensive annual review report is allowed sufficient time to be done fully and to the highest standards.

## Proposed Amendment Text

- 30.C. The licensee shall, on a semiannual frequency, submit a ground-water monitoring report as well as submit a corrective action program review, by **January 30 of the following calendar year**, that describes the progress towards attaining ground-water protection standards.
