We have received the amendment application to update the current and new Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) license for the Metropolis plant to include two fixed radioactive gauges containing sealed sources. Your request has been assigned TAC No. L32367. Please reference this number in any future correspondence associated with this request.

We have completed our formal acceptance review of this application, and based on our projection of current review schedules, we anticipate completing the technical review by April 30, 2007. This date could change depending on the findings of our technical review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule.

In addition, a copy of your submittal has been forwarded to the License Fee and Accounts Receivable Branch, office of the Chief Financial Officer, who will contact you separately if the appropriate license fee has not been submitted for your request, or for billing if your request is subject to full cost fee recovery.
